



## **Prevent Child Abuse Louisiana Volunteer Opportunities**

### **KIDLINE**

KIDLINE is a crisis intervention, parenting support, and referral phone line that serves the families of Louisiana 7 days a week from 8am-8pm. Volunteer will be responsible for attending all of the KIDLINE training and observations followed by a 6 month commitment to answering KIDLINE calls, for a minimum of 12 hours per month.

Volunteers must:

- Be at least 18 years of age, non-judgmental, with good written and oral communication skills
- Be able to listen and communicate effectively
- keep callers' information confidential
- Attend KIDLINE training, which are offered 2 times a year at the Baton Rouge office

### **Internet Safety**

Volunteer will be responsible for facilitating a 90 minute presentation on Internet Safety and Awareness, as requested, to parents, teachers, students, and other concerned adults. In addition, each volunteer will assist the PCA LA regional staff with recruiting potential sites to offer the presentation.

Volunteers must:

- remain available and committed to facilitating presentations
- schedule at least 1-3 trainings per month for a 6 month period
- document all trainings completed and turning in paperwork on time

### **Pinwheels for Prevention**

The Pinwheels for Prevention Campaign is PCA Louisiana's signature public awareness and fundraising campaign that brings to light the belief that child abuse and neglect can be prevented. The pinwheels serve as a symbol of healthy and nurtured children, and it is our goal to have as many planted throughout the state during Child Abuse Prevention Month in April.

Volunteers are needed in the following areas:

- Assist with the distribution of pinwheels to businesses and organizations
- Help plant pinwheels at designated locations
- Man information tables at various locations
- Serve on a Pinwheels for Prevention Committee to help with securing sponsors, media relations, or logistics.
